Cycling to School Policy

This policy has been written by children from the School Council (Class 1 to Class 6 Councillors)

Below are statements outlining the use of bicycles by children, and/or adults while on school property.

- A child should only cycle to school if they are supervised by a parent or have parent's permission (depending on child's age)
- Anyone riding a bike to school must wear a helmet, correctly fastened.
- Bicycles should not be ridden in the school grounds (children and adults should dismount outside the gate and walk.)
- Use the cycle racks for bikes and scooters only.
- Ride safely.
- Bikes must be locked and all equipment is left at the cycle racks at the owner's risk. (Any loss, damage or theft is not the responsibility of the school.)
