Summary

- Scores are significantly higher than in 2017 and have continued to improve in the 2018 data
- Outcomes for disadvantaged pupils are lower than non-disadvantaged pupils by 12%. However, this cohort consists of only 3 children where each child is worth 33%

- Outcomes for children are significantly better than national averages
- Although there were no disadvantaged children in this cohort, the rate of progress made in all three areas is above national average

Summary

- In all attainment areas of the curriculum the 1 disadvantaged child performed as well or above the average non-disadvantaged children
- The disadvantaged child attained above the national averages in all areas of the curriculum
- In Progress, the 1 disadvantaged child performed better than the national average except in Writing

- Although the data is very unreliable due to only one child being disadvantaged, the theme shows that disadvantaged children at Harvey Road School can achieve above the national average and, in Reading and maths, exceed age related expectations
